After reading, if you feel your child Would benefit from having some extra support, complete the consent form attached and have your student return to me or their teacher. I look forward to assisting your student in having an awesome educational journey. Mrs. Wiggins

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**What does a Student Support Coordinator Do?**

We work alongside teachers and caregivers to help students develop socially and emotionally, and to help remove any barriers they have to learning or attending school. Examples of what we can provide are:

- Small group lessons on social skills, managing strong feelings, study skills, etc.
- One-on-one support for students
- Improving caregiver/student communication
- Holiday assistance
- Helping your student be on time to school every day
- Discussing concerns about your student's academic achievement
- Community resource referrals
- Assistance with food, clothing, school supplies, etc.
- And, much more!

**How does a student receive SparkWheel supports?**

- Caregiver referral
- Self-referral
- Peer referral
- Administrator, teacher, or other school staff referral

To refer a student for SparkWheel supports, please call or email me.

Once a student is received, a signed parent/guardian consent must be obtained. After receiving a signed consent form, the student can begin receiving our supports. Students cannot receive individual or small-group supports without a signed consent form.

**SparkWheel Confidentiality**

A student and their caregiver's privacy is very important. All information shared with SparkWheel Student Support Coordinators will remain confidential unless:

- a student shares a plan to harm themselves or someone else
- there is suspicion a student may be a victim of abuse or neglect

In these situations, we are required by law to report this information.

Student Support Coordinators may share information with teachers, counselors, and school staff on a need-to-know basis with student or caregiver permission.
